

# Improve Your Learning Experience on Guitar

1. Make sure your guitar is tuned properly. You can't tell if the chords you are playing sound correct if your guitar is out of tune.
2. Use a variety of play-along songs, such as those found in [Guitar 1 – Start Out Jammin'!](#)
3. Don't get too stuck on any one exercise. Give it your best shot and move on. When you come back to it after working on other things, you'll often find that it somehow got a little easier.
4. Don't feel hurried. A slow steady beat is the best way to master any piece of music. Stay at the slower tempo however long you feel necessary before moving to the higher speed. And even after you do move to the higher speed, know that it's ok to slow it down again and work on the details.
5. Jam with friends. It's never too early to start making music with your friends. Find somebody at your level, more advanced, or even less advanced. Unequal skill levels can be a learning experience for both.
